WHAT TO BRING TO THE TEST SITE:

- Your admission **voucher** (or a printout of your voucher from your online account)
- A current official identification bearing your **photograph** as listed below. Copies will not be accepted. Acceptable forms of official identification include the following: **photo-bearing driver's license, passport or student ID.**
* Social security cards, credit or ATM cards, and retail credit account card are not accepted as an official ID.
- **Several sharpened No. 2 pencils** with clean erasers (no pens) for all multiple-choice answer sheets.
- An analog watch (in case your exam room does not have a clock).

PROHIBITED MATERIALS:

- Electronic devices and media, such as PDAs, pagers, computers, recording devices, etc.
- A watch that beeps or has an alarm.
- Handwritten or printed materials.
- Food and drink, except water in a clear bottle with a secure lid. It must be stored under your seat, not on your desk, during the test.
- Cell phones: Please note that although you are permitted to bring cell phones to the test site, use of cell phones, including ring tones from incoming calls, is strictly prohibited and may result in the voiding of your test scores. Also note that vibrate mode is prohibited as well. All cell phones must be completely **turned off** for the duration of the exam and kept in your bag.

By Car:

From the North:

- Take Highway 101 South, cross the Golden Gate Bridge. Take 19th Avenue/Highway 1 exit. Follow 19th Avenue to campus at Holloway Avenue.
- To get to the parking garage, turn right onto Holloway Ave and continue to Font Blvd.
- Turn right onto Font Blvd. and continue to Lake Merced Blvd.
- Turn right onto Lake Merced Blvd. then take an immediate right onto State Drive, which is the entrance to the parking garage.

From the South:

- Take I-280 North, exit at 19th Avenue.
- Take Junipero Serra Boulevard to Holloway Avenue
- Turn left on Holloway Avenue to campus at 19th Avenue.
- To get to the parking garage, continue on Holloway Ave to Font Blvd. Turn right onto Font Blvd. and continue to Lake Merced Blvd.
- Turn right onto Lake Merced Blvd. then take an immediate right onto State Drive, which is the entrance to the parking garage.

From the East:

- Take I-80 West across the Bay Bridge to Highway 101 South.
- Take 101 South to I-280 toward Daly City.
- Take the San Jose Avenue/Mission St. exit (immediately after the Ocean Avenue exit), bearing right onto Sagamore Street to Brotherhood Way to Junipero Serra Boulevard North.
- Take Junipero Serra Boulevard to Holloway Avenue
- Turn left on Holloway Avenue to campus at 19th Avenue.
- To get directly to the parking garage stay on Brotherhood Way and turn right onto Lake Merced Blvd.
- Turn right onto State Drive, which is the third light after turning onto Lake Merced Blvd. and immediately after Font Blvd.

By BART:

- Take any San Francisco-bound BART train to the **Daly City BART station**.
- SFSU runs a free [shuttle service](#) to campus from the Daly City BART station during the normal school year. Buses are scheduled every 10 to 15 minutes, Monday - Thursday, from 7a.m. until 10:30p.m. (last 19th Ave. pick-up at 10p.m.) and on Fridays from 7a.m. until 7p.m. (last 19th Ave. pick-up at 6:50p.m.).
- There is no shuttle service on weekends, during the summer or on campus holidays.
- MUNI and SamTrans also have bus service from the Daly City BART station.
- MUNI's 28 line and SamTrans' 3B line serve the campus 7 days a week.
- Obtain a transfer (good for one ride to & from BART) from the machine in the lobby before exiting the station. Exit at the 19th Ave. & Holloway Ave. stop.

By MUNI :**From downtown San Francisco:**

- Take MUNI Metro M-Oceanview streetcar.
- The campus is also served by the following MUNI bus lines:
 - M-** Oceanview- streetcar to downtown and Balboa Park Station.
 - 17-** Park Merced to West Portal Station.
 - 18-** 46th Avenue/Zoo, Sunset and Richmond Districts, Palace of the Legion of Honor.
 - 28-** 19th Avenue to Daly City BART station, Sunset and Richmond Districts, Golden Gate Bridge, Fort Mason. (28L- limited service Monday-Friday only).
 - 29-** Sunset to Ingleside, Excelsior, Bayview districts and Candlestick Park.

Lot 20 Garage:

- General paid public, visitor/guest, student parking
- Open 24-hours a days, 7 days a week.
- \$1 per hour with a \$5 maximum per day. Pay stations will accept quarter, \$1, \$5 and \$10 bills as well as prepaid debit cards.
- \$20 and \$50 prepaid debit cards are available at the Bursar's Office in the Administration building and at the One Stop Shop in the Student Service Building. Debit cards are NOT available at the Parking Office.
- Level 4i Orange to 4n Orange and the roof level is restricted to staff and faculty between 7a.m. and 5p.m. Monday - Friday.

Lot 25:

- General paid public, visitor/guest, student parking.
- Seven days a week 7a.m. to 10p.m.
- \$1 per hour with a \$5 maximum per day. Pay stations will accept quarter, \$1, \$5 and \$10 bills as well as prepaid debit cards.
- \$20 and \$50 prepaid debit cards are available at the Bursar's Office in the Administration building and at the One Stop Shop in the Student Service Building. Debit cards are NOT available at the Parking Office.
